## POST SHOW REPORT

Exhibitors at AGRA 2013 were **385 companies from 17 countries** presenting their products at the most prestigious agricultural forum in Southeast Europe. The exhibition was visited by **26,995 visitors from 17 countries**. Argentina, Greece and Turkey registered official participation.

The livestock sector was in the highlights of AGRA 2013. The best breeds in Bulgaria were demonstrated in a specially designated pavilion along with a large number of innovations and livestock farming equipment.

The exhibition BioAgra promoted the active development of the modern agriculture, i.e. organic farming, which brought together producers, research institutes and non-governmental organizations at International Fair Plovdiv for the second year in a row.

# THEY SAID ABOUT US




